Aravo Enable is a core component of Aravo's market-leading Supplier Information Management (SIM) platform. By automating and managing supplier enablement, *Aravo Enable* allows you to reduce supplier management costs while driving improvements in source to settle systems ROI.

ADD SUPPLIERS

Aravo Enable simplifies and automates new supplier on-boarding, whether it's a single supplier or an entire new supplier master. Using best practices developed through on-boarding over 1.5 million suppliers, *Aravo Enable* allows you to collect supplier profile information, catalog data, contract information and 3rd party enrichment data accurately and quickly. Best practice Add Supplier steps include:

1. For buyer-initiated supplier invitations, a supplier receives an email invite that directs them to a web-based portal where they complete online customizable surveys that capture relevant business and regulatory information such as location, products/services offered, and diversity and small business characteristics, credentials, and compliance information.
2. For supplier master file consolidation, missing information is added, supplier data is enriched with 3rd party information, and standard validations are performed before the suppliers are added to the Aravo Network.
3. For accounts payable additions, an AP clerk can search the existing supplier network for a match, and either use an existing supplier or create a new addition for the payment transaction.
4. For supplier catalog and contract loads, catalog requests are made by the system, and catalog and/or contract data is loaded into the appropriate template and added.
5. User-defined workflows manage review, approval, and validation of data.

MAINTAIN SUPPLIERS

Supplier information changes and retirement processes are also managed by *Aravo Enable* with simple self-service portals, and supported by enterprise system integration to align with your MDM strategy. With *Aravo Enable*, a supplier utilizes a simple portal to enter data changes which are routed for approvals and syndicated to all relevant downstream systems. Best practice Maintain Supplier steps include:

1. Supplier updates are triggered by a workflow event such as a certificate expiration, or by a system user or a supplier.
2. For system triggered events, an email is automatically sent to suppliers requesting the required updates or information.
3. Supplier logs onto web-portal and enters appropriate data.
4. User-defined workflows manage review, approval, validation, and downstream syndication of updated data.
5. When suppliers are retired, they are flagged as inactive and do not require ongoing management costs.
